



100 Towns Improvement Program

The Urban Development Authority (UDA) has already commenced the formulation and development of plans for building a fully equipped urban system in order to make the present state manifesto, “Vistas of Prosperity and Splendour,” a reality. One of the particular projects identified under this initiative is the '100 Towns Improvement Program.' For this purpose, 100 towns that required physical improvement will be selected by Urban Development Authority.

The main objectives of the program will be

- To implement basic infrastructure development projects to facilitate the local economy
- To implement town beautification projects in order to enhance a liveable urban environment in identified towns.

Accordingly, the specific projects to each town will be identified in order to achieve the objectives under the strategies such as re-establishment and rehabilitation of disorder constructions, ensure safe pedestrian mobility, ensure convenient traffic movement and launch landscaping and beautification projects and urban infrastructure development projects. The estimated total cost for this program is about Rs 2000 mn.

As the key state agency responsible for urban development, the Urban Development Authority expects to implement this unique program through the regional and district office network by coordinating with the other relevant state agencies and local politicians. The identified projects will be launched immediately and be completed by the end of the year 2021.
